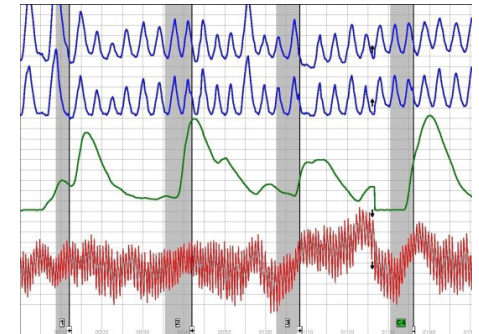

*Pre-Employment Principles - this is an overview of pre-employment testing, the latest research into pre-employment screening tests and what we anticipate is coming for credibility assessment in the future.

*Pre-Test Procedures to Reduce Inconclusives - this is a list of pre-test procedures for examiners designed to produce clearer test data and reduce inconclusive results.

*Single Issue Screening Test (SIST) - this is a new concept, derived from the DLST which is quickly gaining popularity from agencies for conclusive results and elimination of "breakout" testing.

*Memory Enhancement Techniques for polygraphing witnesses and victims. This is an approach highlighting Cognitive Interviewing that has been shown to dramatically improve witnesses' recall of specific events.

Detective Morgan is also a certified Clinical Polygraph Examiner in Sex Offender testing methodology, fully certified to administer Post Conviction Sex Offender Testing by the APA and the Idaho Sex Offender Management Board.

He holds an Associate of Arts in Criminal Justice Administration and a Bachelor of Science degree in International Security Management and Intelligence. Chip is a qualified as an expert and has testified in Idaho and California State Courts and the United States Federal Court system. Chip Morgan holds a master's certification from the Peace Officer Standards and Training Council and has been a certified Law Enforcement Instructor since 1980 and a Polygraph Science Instructor since 2010.

Chip is a published author and recognized expert in the art of Interview and Interrogation. His text, *Focused Interviewing* 2013 has been a course text at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in Glynco, Georgia as well as the Peace Officers Standards and Training center in Boise, Idaho. Chip holds a Lifetime Achievement Award from the National Polygraph Association, the Max Wastl Lifetime Achievement Award from the American Association of Police Polygraphers and the Cleve Backster Lifetime Achievement Award from the American Polygraph Association.
